Craft Time

1. Balloon Dad.

Talk about - Our Dad's can be special people in our lives and God is often seen as a father to us.

You will need: balloon, scissors, glue, coloured paper.

- Blow up a balloon.
- Cut out different shapes from coloured paper to make your face.
- Stick the features to the balloon to make your balloon Dad!



2. God's Love Book Mark.

Talk about - God's love is like a loving Father. He loves us and wants us to love him.

You will need: card, pens, stickers.

- Cut out a cross shape from card.
- Write 'Love God' on the cross.
- Decorate using pens and stickers

3. A Jar of Love.

Talk about - Sometimes we can show how much we love someone by giving them a gift. Why not make this for your dad or a special person in your life.

You will need; an empty jar, tissue paper, scissors and glue.

- Cut some tissue paper up into small squares.
- Stick the tissue squares onto the jar so that it is covered in colourful paper. Perhaps you can choose some favourite colours?
- Fill the jar with something your chosen person will like; for example toffees, smarties or sweets.

4. Safe in God's Hands.

Talk about - We are part of God's family and he loves us and keeps us safe.

You will need: coloured card/paper, scissors, pens.

- On different coloured paper, draw around and cut out your hand along with the hands of your family.
- Draw another hand onto card which will be the largest hand.
- Stick the hands on top of each other and add your names.
- Label the largest hand as God's and write the words, 'keeping us safe in his hands on the card.



5. Food craft - Pizza Badge

Talk about - Our Dad's are number 1!

You will need: a round pizza base, tomatoes, cheese, pepperoni, pepper.

- Cut tomatoes in half, strips of pepper and grate some cheese.
- Cut out a number '1' shape using pepperoni or something you would like to add to you pizza topping.
- Decorate your pizza with tomatoes around the edge to form the outer edge of the badge shape and place cheese all over the top of your pizza.
- Add the number 1 shape to the centre and pepper to make a 'bow' at the bottom.







Meal Time

As it is Father's Day this month, why not make a special meal? In normal times, we may take our Dad's out for dinner to a special restaurant. Why not find out your Dad's favourite meal and cook it for him? You could even make a menu like they have in cafes and restaurants and serve your Dad! Alternatively, you can serve him the pizza you have just made!
